Proposed Consent Agenda

The Alcohol License Review Committee uses a consent agenda. Typical consent agenda items are routine, procedural decisions, and decisions that are likely to be noncontroversial. It can also include conditions that have been agreed to by the applicant. If you are here appearing for your liquor license application tonight, and your agenda item appears on this consent agenda, you are not required to speak in front of the committee. Each item on the consent agenda will be read aloud and if there are no objections by committee members, alders, staff, or citizens registered to speak on the item, the item will be approved with any recommended action as stated on the consent agenda. If you still wish to speak, or if you would like the ALRC not to take action on your item this evening, please inform the clerk.

If you are here to testify on an agenda item, and would like to make sure you speak, check the box “wishes to speak.”

Why is a consent agenda used?

The consent agenda is used by the ALRC to save meeting time and to help ensure that meetings focus on substantive topics that are worth discussion. Through the “bundling” process, the entire set of routine agenda items can be voted on in one action versus taking the time to vote on each individual item.

Please note that this consent agenda may change at the meeting. Items may be added or taken off the list when the consent agenda is presented. Items numbers correspond to those on the full agenda.
